The works presented in this exhibition range from poetic reflections, like Anna Boggon's glass branches, resin cast bamboo ladders and periscope-cabinet, to a sense of bewilderment and outsider-ness transferred upon the audience in Lu Chunsheng's 29-minute narrative video, The History Of Chemistry.
